AIR CREEBEC EVENT AT ROUYN-NORANDA AIRPORT

Val-d'Or, January 24, 2019 - Air Creebec experienced an event which resulted in damage to one of its Dash-8 aircraft on Wednesday, January 23 at 21:37 local time at the Rouyn-Noranda airport. The event occurred during takeoff and resulted in the aircraft being forced to reject the takeoff, which caused the aircraft to partially leave the runway area. The event has been reported to the Transportation Board and we are actively investigating the incident.
