Before answering the following questions on the health check, I would like to advise you that providing a false or misleading answer could result in a maximum fine of \$5,000.

1. Do you have a fever AND/OR a cough? If YES or passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.

2. Do you have a fever AND/OR breathing difficulty? If YES or passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.

3. Have you experienced any loss of smell or taste in the past few weeks? If YES or passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.

4. Do you have or suspect that you have COVID-19? If Yes or passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.

5. Have you been refused boarding in the past 14 days due to a medical reason related to COVID-19? **If YES or passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding**.

6. Are you currently under mandatory quarantine, as a result of recent travel or by orders from the provincial, territorial or local public health authorities? **If YES**, has a federal, provincial or territorial health authority given you explicit permission to continue your onward journey by air to reach your self-isolation location? **If No explicit permission, deny boarding. If the passenger refuses to answer the question, deny boarding.** 

7. Do you have a removable mask or face covering with which to cover your mouth and nose while moving through the airport and on board the flight **or** do you have a medical certificate certifying that you are unable to wear a mask or face covering due to medical reasons? **If NO, or if the passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.** 

8. Do you confirm that you understand that you may be denied boarding a flight leaving a Canadian airport for a period of 14 days if you have an elevated temperature (fever), unless a medical certificate is presented indicating that it is not related to COVID-19? If NO, or if the passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.

9. FOR DOMESTIC FLIGHTS ONLY: Do you confirm that you may be subject to a measure that the provincial, territorial or federal government has put in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19 when you arrive at your destination? If NO, or if the passenger refuses to answer, deny boarding.
